

Commuting Patterns of the Pelham NH Portion of the Lowell-Billerica-Chelmsford MA-NH NECTA Division

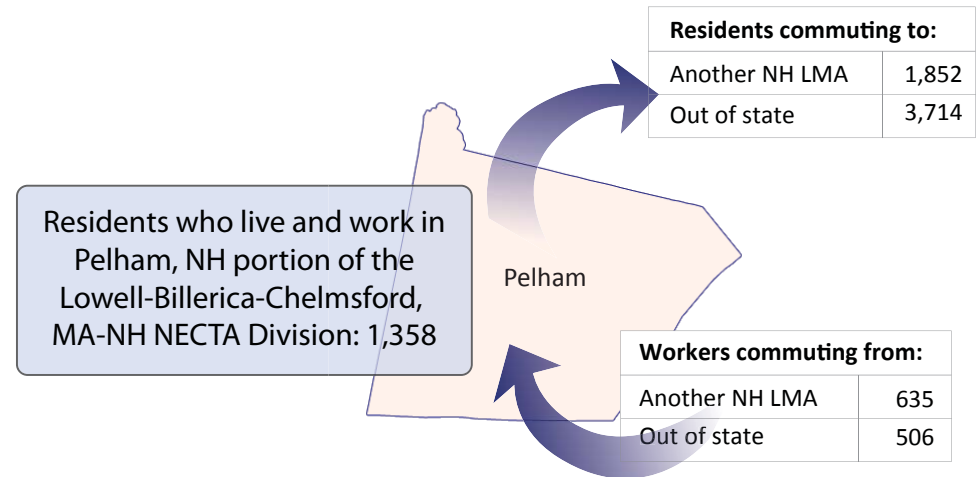
There were 1,358 residents of the Pelham NH portion of the Lowell-Billerica-Chelmsford MA-NH NECTA Division, age 16 and over, who both live and work within the area.

Where Workers of the Pelham NH Portion of the Lowell-Billerica-Chelmsford MA-NH NECTA Division Live

- ➔ On average, 2,499 commuters, age 16 and over, travel to work in the Pelham NH portion of the Lowell-Billerica-Chelmsford MA-NH NECTA Division.
- ➔ Among those commuting to work in the Pelham NH portion of the NECTA Division: 54.3 percent also live in the area; 25.4 percent live in another New Hampshire LMA; and 20.3 percent live out-of-state.
- ➔ Of those commuting in from elsewhere in New Hampshire: 376 live in the NH portion of the Nashua NH-MA NECTA Division; 64 live in the NH portion of the Haverhill-Newburyport-Amesbury MA-NH NECTA Division; and 64 live in the Manchester NH MetroNECTA.

Where Residents of the Pelham NH Portion of the Lowell-Billerica-Chelmsford MA-NH NECTA Division Work

- ➔ On average, 6,924 residents of the Pelham NH portion of the Lowell-Billerica-Chelmsford MA-NH NECTA Division, age 16 and over, travel to work.
- ➔ Among residents of the Pelham NH portion of the NECTA Division who commute to work: 19.6 percent also live in the area; 26.8 percent work in another New Hampshire LMA; and 53.6 percent work out-of-state.
- ➔ Of the residents commuting outside the Pelham NH portion of the NECTA Division for work: 860 work in the NH portion of the Nashua NH-MA NECTA Division; 469 work in the Salem NH portion of the Lawrence-Methuen-Salem MA-NH NECTA Division; and 292 work on the Manchester NH MetroNECTA.
